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## **1. INTRODUCTION:**

The documentation for this data set was originally on paper, kept in NSSDC's Data Set Catalogs (DSCs). The paper documentation in the Data Set Catalogs have been made into digital images, and then collected into a single PDF file for each Data Set Catalog. The inventory information in these DSCs is current as of July 1, 2004. This inventory information is now no longer maintained in the DSCs, but is now managed in the inventory part of the NSSDC information system. The information existing in the DSCs is now not needed for locating the data files, but we did not remove that inventory information.

The offline tape datasets have now been migrated from the original magnetic tape to Archival Information Packages (AIP's).

A prior restoration may have been done on data sets, if a requestor of this data set has questions; they should send an inquiry to the request office to see if additional information exists.

Files one and three contain respectively 324 and 280 unformatted records of data taken at three-second intervals. Each file is terminated by one end-of-file mark. Each physical record contains one logical record. The records are 404 words long. The first four words specify year, month, day and hour. 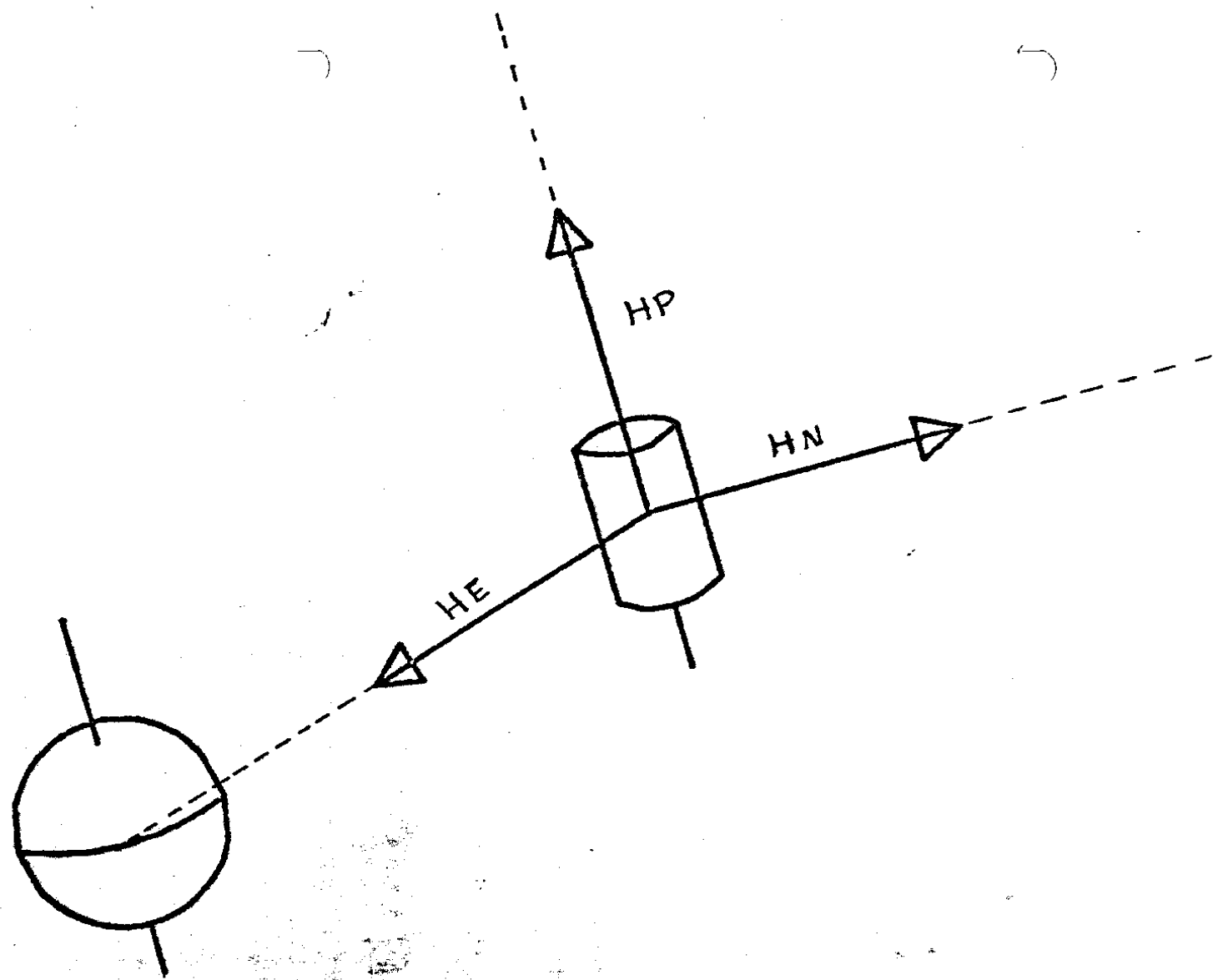
Other than the first four words (time information), all values have been multiplied by 100 so that they could be written as binary integers to facilitate reading. Space for 100 samples for each component (TIME, HP, HE, HN) was allocated to each five-minute period. It has turned out that the last eight words are superfluous. These excess words, as well as data gaps of less than a full five-minute period, have been filled with the value of -99900. Data gaps covering one or more full five-minute periods have been ignored.

The second and fourth files each contain 96 unformatted records of five-minute averages of the above data. The second file is followed by one end-of-file mark, while the fourth, and final, file is followed by at least two end-of-file marks.

Again each physical record contains one logical record. Each record contains 40 words. The first four words are again, year, month, day and hour. Each record contains one hour's worth of five-minute average, e.g.:

All data gaps have been filled with zeroes. However, a value of zero indicates missing data only if it occurs in all three components. Again, all data values have been multiplied by 100 and written as integers using an unformatted WRITE statement.
