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1. INTRODUCTION:

The documentation for this data set was originally on paper, kept in NSSDC's Data Set Catalogs (DSCs). The paper documentation in the Data Set Catalogs have been made into digital images, and then collected into a single PDF file for each Data Set Catalog. The inventory information in these DSCs is current as of July 1, 2004. This inventory information is now no longer maintained in the DSCs, but is now managed in the inventory part of the NSSDC information system. The information existing in the DSCs is now not needed for locating the data files, but we did not remove that inventory information.

The offline tape datasets have now been migrated from the original magnetic tape to Archival Information Packages (AIP's).

A prior restoration may have been done on data sets, if a requestor of this data set has questions; they should send an inquiry to the request office to see if additional information exists.

This data set has been restored. There were originally 32 9-track, 1600 BPI tapes written in EBCDIC. There are nine restored tapes. The DR tapes are 3480 cartridges and the DS tapes are 9-track, 6250 BPI. The tapes were created on a Sigma 5 computer. SUBJ: IUE Flux Particle Monitor Data Recording

The IUE Flux Particle Monitor data will be extracted from IUE telemetry, recorded on disk, and dumped to tape weekly. The tape will then be delivered to the GSFC National Science Data Center (Code 601). Additional data is required to provide spacecraft orbit and attitude information associated with the data. The following provides a definition of the requirements for this capability.

1. Determine the median value of the Flux Particle Monitor (ASC2 Ch1) over a time interval of N minutes ($3 \leq N \leq 10$). Default value N=5 min.
2. The required data will be placed in a file on the "Shared Disk" which will have the capacity for at least one week of data, when N=3.
3. A background job (program) will be provided for dumping this "Shared Disk" file to tape. This job will also reinitialize the Shared Disk after the data has been dumped to tape.
4. The tape format of the data will be as follows: (248 bytes EBCDIC)
